## 'Around the Corner'

block


Please read all instructions before starting. All fabric measurements have $1 / 4$ inch seam allowance included. Unfinished block measures $12^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{1 / 2 "}$. When pressing seams, press towards darker fabric unless otherwise stated. Arrows show direction of pressing seams. Place right sides together when piecing. Remember to square off the final block so that it is an even square and to get rid of jagged edges.

## Requirements:

-1 x cutting mat, 1 x rotary cutter, $1 \times$ quilt ruler - Sewing thread (I use natural coloured 100\% cotton
-1 x charm pack of your favourite quilting fabric and 1 fat eighth of white background fabric.

## Cutting the fabric

Fabric requirements for 1 block are as follows: Background (white)

& A=(4 x) 41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 41 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \\
& B=(2 x) 21 / 2 " x 1 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime \prime} \\
& C=(1 x) 41 / 2 " x 21 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \\
& D=(8 x) 31 / 2 \times x{ }^{11 / 2}{ }^{\prime \prime} \\
& E=(4 x) 11 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 11 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}

## Colour 1 (blue)

$$
\begin{aligned}
& \mathrm{F}=(8 \mathrm{x}) 1^{1 / 2}{ }^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{x} 11 / 2{ }^{\text {" }} \\
& G=(4 x) 31 / 2 \times x 21 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \\
& H=(4 x) 21 / 2 " x 1 \frac{1}{2} \text { " }
\end{aligned}

## Let's begin..

Stitch fabric H rectangle to fabric E square. Press.


Make 4
Stitch fabric G to unit. Press.


Stitch fabric D rectangle to unit. Press.


Stitch fabric F square to fabric D rectangle. Press.


Make 4

Assemble unit as shown in diagram. Press.



Make 4

Stitch fabric F square to fabric B rectangle. Press.


Together with fabric C rectangle, stitch unit together as shown in the diagram. Press.


Make 1
Together with fabric A square, stitch units together. Press.
